
SCWIST presents the *ms infinity* Youth Skills Development Scholarship

In celebration of Canada's 150 birthday, the Society for Canadian Women in Science and Technology announces a new **Youth Skills Development Scholarship**. The goal is to foster another 150 years of innovation and excellence in Canada. The scholarship is open to girls (age 16-21) who have participated in Quantum Leaps conferences or eMentoring and is awarded to cover costs of professional development. The scholarship can be used to cover costs of attending Science Fair or participating in science-related camps or courses. This \$500 scholarship must be put towards the cost of professional development of equal or greater value, this includes associated costs or attendance. The successful applicant will be required to write a summary of their experience participating in their chosen skills development program. This summary will be shared through SCWIST media channels. Please note that the scholarship is conditional on acceptance and participation in a skills development program or event.

Application Requirements

- You have participated in a Quantum Leaps conference or the eMentoring program in the last 5 years (since 2012). You will be asked to provide evidence of participation.
- You identify as female.
- Aged 16-21 as of May 31, 2017
